







New Mezzanine Floor

Hawkins Steel Ltd were awarded the contract to design, fabricate and install a new mezzanine floor to be used as a storage area for manufacturing company in Stokenchurch.

This mezzanine was required to fit around the clients existing layout whilst ensuring they maximize the space available. Our in-house design team supplied detailed layout drawings for the client's approval before beginning work.

The steel was fabricated onsite in our steel workshop before being taken to site and installed. All steelwork was fabricated in accordance with BS EN 1090-2 to Execution Class 2

Works undertaken included:

- Supply and installation of the new mezzanine floor 15.4m x 10.8m x 3.2m High
- Columns installed and positioned to fit around the clients existing ground floor layout
- 38mm particle flooring
- Double flight staircase with a galvanized tube clamp handrail
- Galvanised Tube Clamp handrail edge protection & pallet gate
- Folded Galvanised Kick Plate
- All steelwork to be painted with a grey finish as per the client's request.
- LED lighting to the underside of the mezzanine
- Smoke detection units to integrate into clients existing system

All of the main installation was carried out over one weekend so that the client could operate without any disruption to their daily operations.
