Our experienced fabricators work with mild steel, stainless steel, aluminium and bronze. The installation of our new FICEP Excalibur drill line and Masterflo Mastre-Flex retractable spray booth is a testament to our commitment to challenge the way we do things internally and to continually look at ways to improve efficiency. The milling and etching attachment which marks all the plate locations is particularly beneficial; we have seen a 25% increase in productivity since their introduction.

This highly advanced piece of equipment works seamlessly with our in-house BIM software, so you can also make real-time design updates. While you are exploring and inspecting your virtual building, changes can be requested on the spot; they'll be made there and then by one of our experienced design technicians.

Two further companies, Hawkins Projects Ltd and Hawkins Estates were established. The diversification of our business saw the start of us expanding our services within the UK, and working on projects in Europe, the Americas, and the Far East with international contracts. 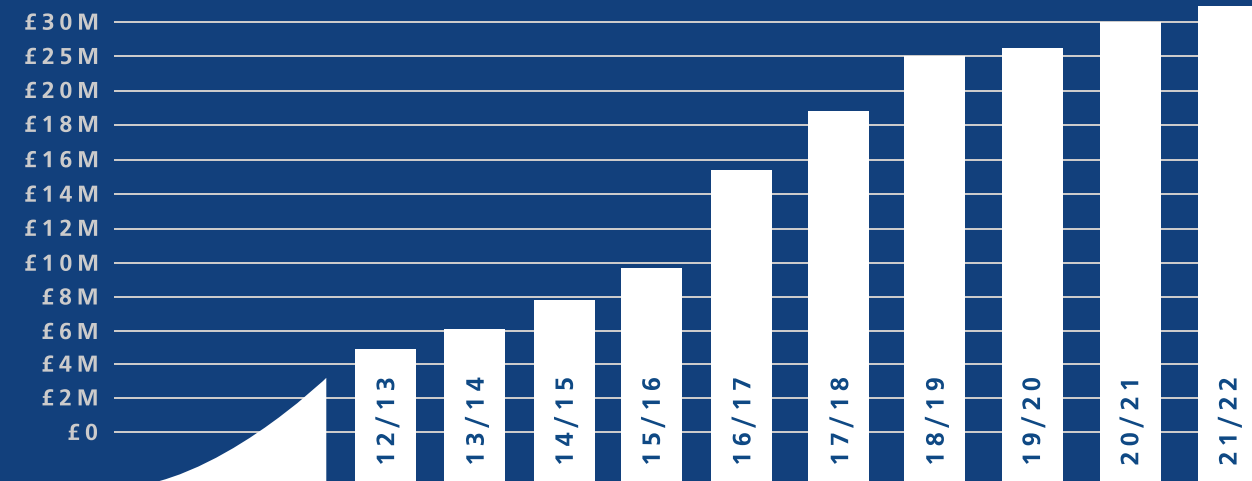
Although our actual sales fell short of our forecast due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it was still another record year for the group.

The 450m² barn's structural steel frame is set on new concrete pads and strip foundations. The building interior benefits from a smooth power floated floor, a mezzanine platform with handrails and a staircase to the central core. Internal partitioning has been installed to create a plant room, office and toilets with drainage.

The building exterior benefits from the quality insulated roof and side cladding, high end thermo glazing sectional door and large contemporary composite windows. The exterior is beautifully finished with ethically and sustainably sourced chestnut timber panelling, an ideal finish to complement its rural setting.

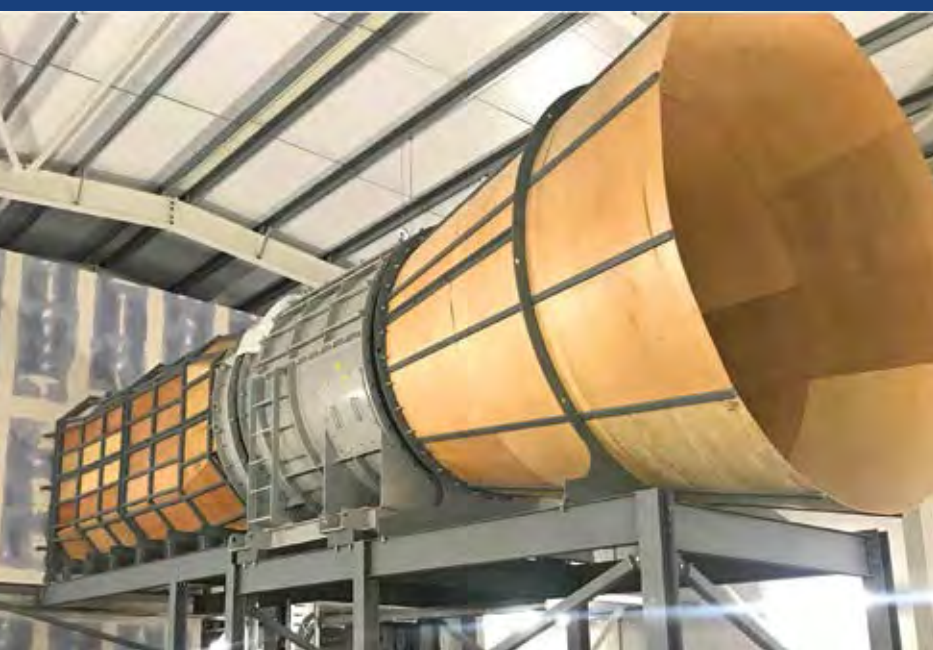
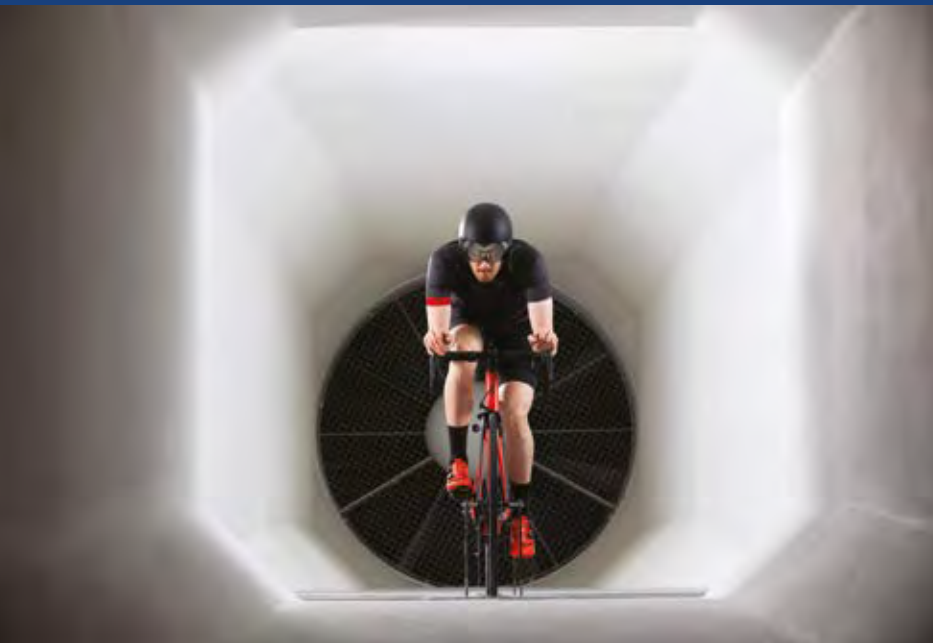

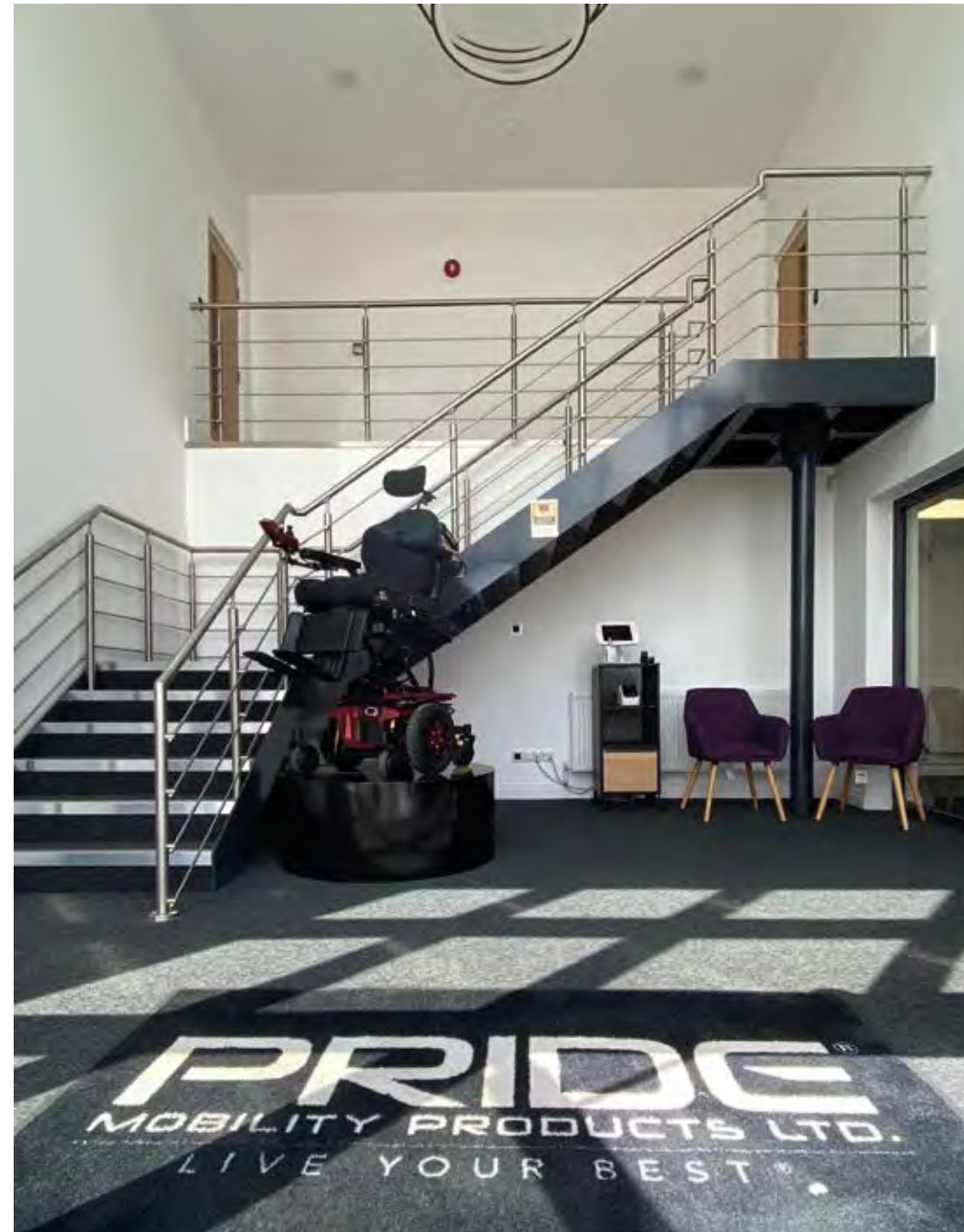
Differing from existing wind tunnel facilities used for aerospace and automotive development, this facility is the first of its kind in Europe used for the measurement of dynamic drag for non-motorised sports applications.

The wind tunnel itself was fabricated in our steel workshop before being dismantled and delivered to site to be installed along with a prep room and control room to form part of the overall facility.

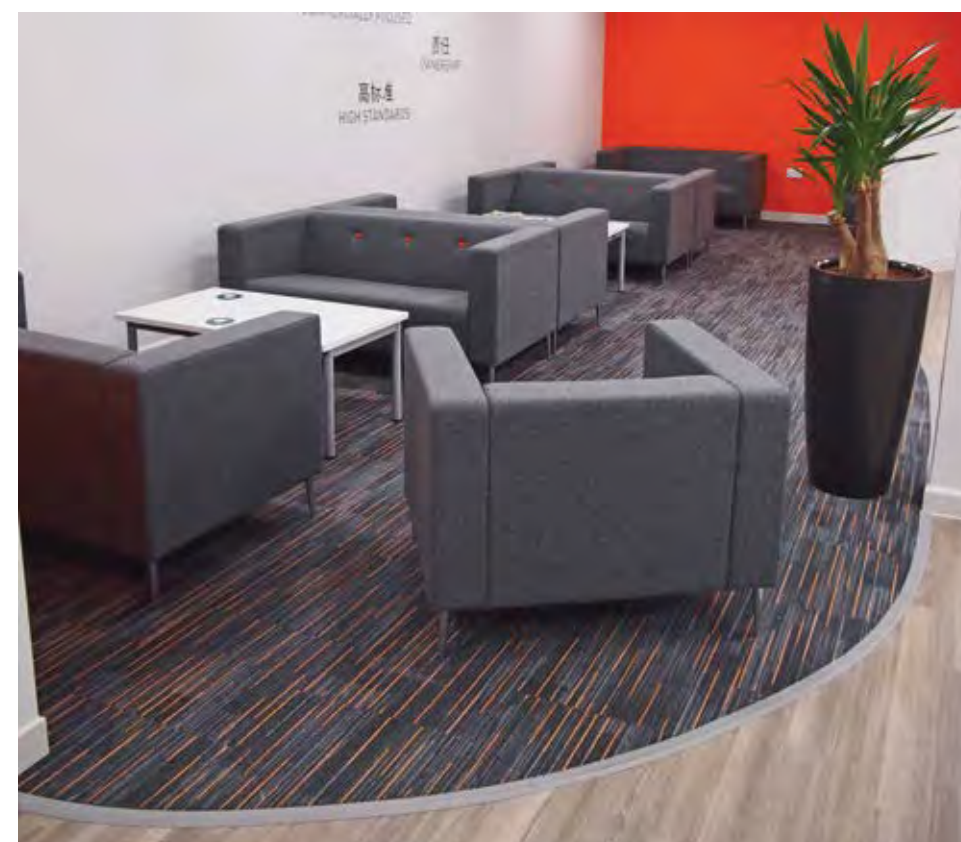

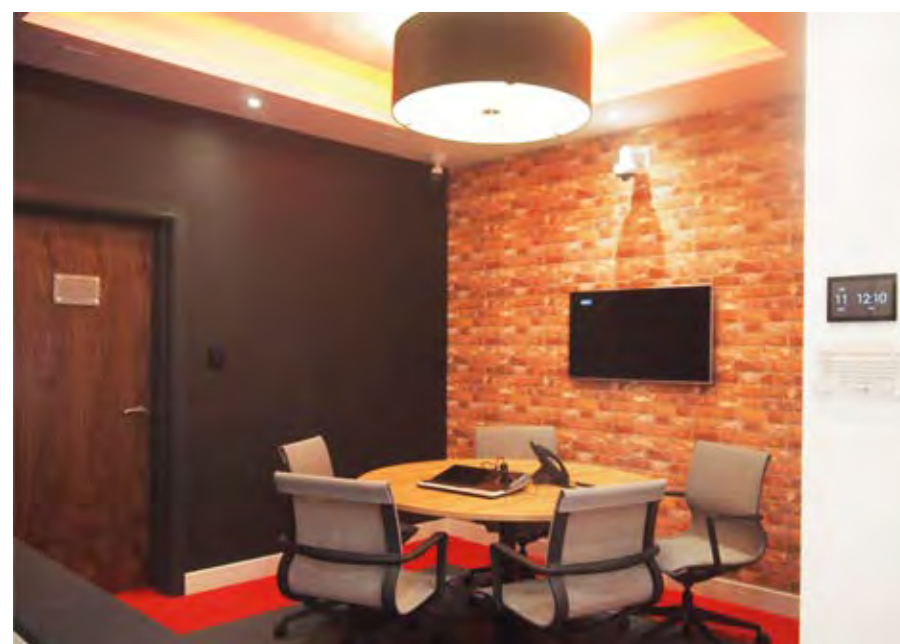

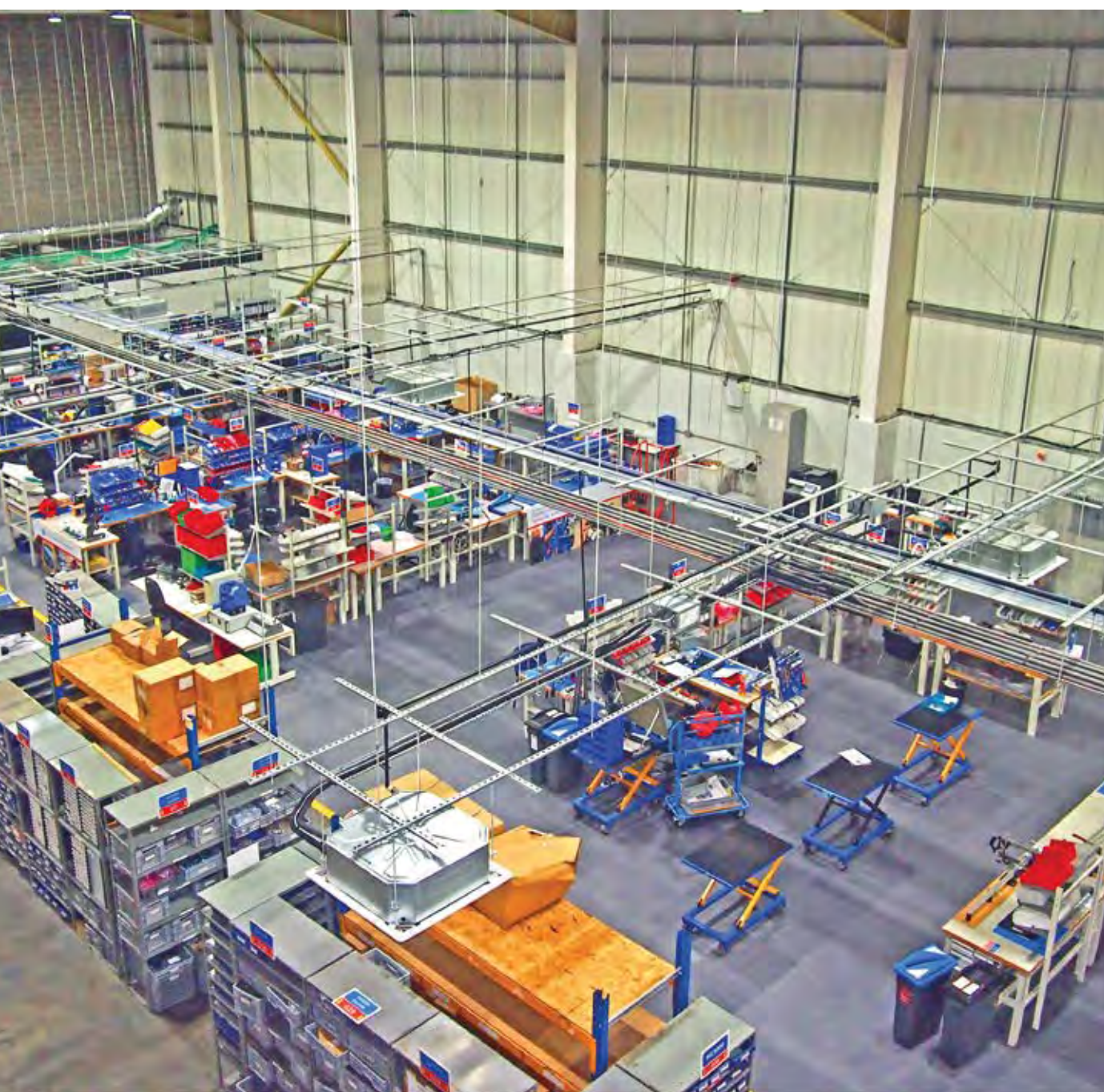

The high quality building envelope not only carries a high performance and robust finish, it also displays a clean contemporary feel by mixing natural colour tones of Anthracite Grey with Seren Copper to tastefully integrate with its surroundings.

The external works also comprised of replacement windows, doors and overhead insulated roller shutter doors. The 1,500m² roof is clad with a traditional Goosewing Grey TATA Steel insulated overclad system.

Office areas, kitchenettes and accessible toilets were constructed to offer the occupants a practical and pleasant working environment.

Work undertaken by Hawkins Projects included:

- Supply and install wall cladding and window flashings.
- Supply and install overclad roofing system.

We love to support events and contribute locally whenever we can. As a family-run business, our local community is very important to us.



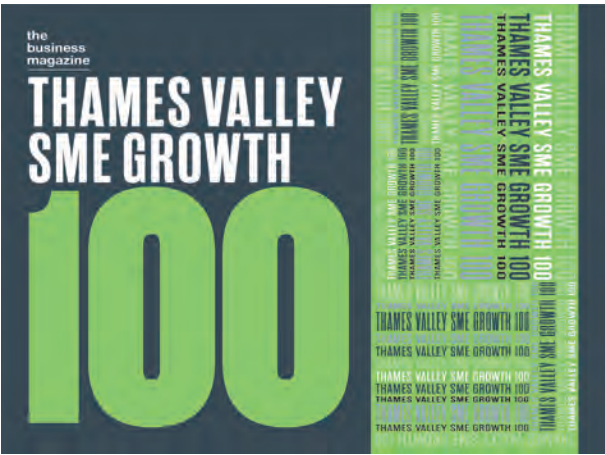
